

What is the difference between a “corridor” and an “alignment”?

When we conduct a location study for a highway project, we start with general information and then get more specific and refined over time. Using this approach, we start by looking at possible routes at the broad corridor level, asking very general questions about where the project should be built.

Once one corridor location is selected as the best, then various roadway locations can be drawn, within the selected corridor. This is the process that is being used on the Eastern Bypass project.
