

# Community Advisory Group (CAG) Roles and Responsibilities

## Roles

A key part of our study process will be the creation of a Community Advisory Group. The Group will:

- *Ensure that the opinions of the broader community are shared with the IDOT project team.*
- *Ensure that information developed by the project team is distributed throughout the community.*
- *Help ensure that the best possible corridor is identified.*
- *Generate interest and knowledge among the general public about the Eastern Bypass Study.*

In carrying out these functions, the CAG will play an important role in defining the area's important features, identifying highway preferences, and recognizing potential highway effects.

## Responsibilities

Advisory Group members will be expected to carry out the following responsibilities:

- *Attend each CAG meeting and participate in Group discussion and activities.*
- *Participate openly and honestly, respecting the opinions of other Group members.*
- *Endorse the roles of the Group, as outlined above.*
- *Represent their organization, constituency, or broader community interests.*

Membership on the CAG is an important job, but we also expect it to be an educational, rewarding experience for all involved.
