- Should you wish to ask questions or make a statement, we ask that you please take advantage of one of several ways to do so, as shown below.
- Put cell phones and other devices on vibrate. If you must take a call, completely leave the area.

To members of the news media:

- Please adhere to the ground rules listed above. Additionally, please refrain from taking photographs or video during the course of the meeting. There will be opportunities for interviews after the completion of the CAG meeting.
